
Subject: **Commitment of Cooperation for the Strategy to Improve Service Delivery and Financial Viability of the Karachi Water and Sewerage Board**

On May, 2019 the Government of Sindh announced a Strategy for Improving Service Delivery and Financial Viability of the Karachi Water and Sewerage Board, with the support of the World Bank Group.


The Strategy is summarized in the Attachment. The key areas of the Strategy are Service Delivery, Institutional Development, Financial Viability and Private Sector Participation.

To support implementation of the Strategy, the Government of Sindh has on [insert date] issued a Notification that constitutes a Steering Committee comprising representatives of the Government, KWSB and relevant stakeholders including, but not limited, to representatives from the private sector and development partners.

The Committee will be chaired by the Chairperson, P&D Board and will meet on a quarterly basis. A coordination unit will be housed in Planning & Development Department, Government of Sindh. The Committee will guide the Strategy through the following functions:


- i. Within 3 months of the Committee's inception, develop short term (by 2021), medium term (by 2025) and long term (by 2031) action plans, with annual milestones, in order to achieve the Strategy's goals as shown in the Attachment.
- ii. Review, approve and, when necessary, adjust the Strategy's recommendations.
- iii. Identify and mobilize technical assistance and financial resources (domestic, international public and private) to assist in achieving the Strategy's objectives.
- iv. Provide oversight of monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of the Strategy.
